



SOUTHWEST SECTION WOMEN PILOT OF THE YEAR
APPLICATION AND PROCESS
RECREATIONAL – OR - PROFESSIONAL

Dear Applicant,

The SWS Women Pilot of the Year (WPOY) process has been revised/updated. Those of you who were present at the SWS Winter Workshop last January in Oakland are aware of the shortcomings the old application and point system presented. Once thought to be a fair process, it truly was not and the point system had too many discrepancies. The new process is as follows:

- 1) There is no longer a 3-year window. All accomplishments from day one count.
- 2) The application itself is only one-page (see below).
- 3) The applicant can either apply herself or be nominated by others.
- 4) In addition to the application, include an essay (no more than 500 words).
- 5) One letter of recommendation from within The Ninety-Nines, Inc.
- 6) One letter of recommendation from outside The Ninety-Nines, Inc. (employer, etc.).
- 7) The deadline for submittal of your WPOY package is **September 15, 2011**.
- 8) Submit to Pat Prentiss, 225 Opal Avenue, Balboa Island, California 92662

While the above is the minimum requirements, you may also include any other supporting documentation (newspaper articles, magazine articles, etc.).
