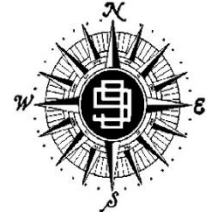


Placer Gold Chapter of the 99s Julia Huber Memorial Scholarship of \$1,000



The purpose of the International Organization of Women Pilots is to promote women in aviation and support them in reaching their aviation goals. The Placer Gold Chapter of the Ninety-Nines, Inc. is sponsoring an aviation scholarship for women in the amount of **\$1,000**. The purpose of this memorial scholarship is to defray the cost of obtaining a private pilot license or an advanced rating in the field of aviation.

The applicant must be:

- Female
- 16 years of age or older (parent's permission for under 18 years of age)
- Proficient in English and a US citizen
- Live within 99 nautical miles of the Auburn Municipal Airport
- Actively pursuing flight training
- Applicant must have passed the written exam, soloed and have a current medical certificate for the rating pursued.
- If an advanced rating is a goal, the applicant must have a current flight review and all prerequisite ratings for the rating she seeks.

Application guidelines:

- Financial need will be a consideration
- Final applicants will be notified and should be prepared for a personal interview on March 8, 2012 at the Auburn Airport
- Award money must be used during the 12 months immediately following the presentation of the scholarship.
- Monthly progress updates will be required from instructor/flight school.
- Placer Gold Chapter will disburse funds at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee directly to the flight school or instructor.
- Applications must be postmarked by February 29, 2012.
- Winner will be notified of the scholarship award by March 31, 2012.
- Application must be completed in full using the attached form. Any item not completed may result in disqualification.
- Final selection of the recipient will be made by a committee comprised of aviation-related individuals who are not members of the Placer Gold 99s chapter plus one member of the Placer Gold Scholarship Committee.
- If there are no qualified applicants, as deemed by aviation-related individuals, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold the scholarship award.
- Upon completion of the application, **mail original and three copies of application, personal essay, budget information, flight information and two letters of recommendation (one letter must be from a person knowledgeable of your interest or accomplishments in aviation) to:**

- What aviation related activities you have participated in

- Are there any obstacles you may have to overcome to continue your aviation goals
- How you would contribute to the 99s and the aviation community
- Please include any information regarding: violations, accidents, refusal or lost medical, or termination from any flying job.

Budget Information

- Please provide a budget of anticipated expenses for the license/rating sought.
- The budget submitted should be signed by the flight school or independent instructor you plan to use to obtain the license/rating.
- Other anticipated funding and/or scholarship aid.
- Any other special circumstances regarding your financial need.

Flight Information – bring originals to interview

- License(if applicable)/ratings
- Current medical certificate
- Log book
- Certificate for passing written test for rating pursued

Letters of Recommendation

- Submit two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a person knowledgeable about your interest or accomplishments in aviation.

Terms

Recipient will provide in writing monthly updates regarding progress of her training as well as monthly updates from flight school or instructor.

If the recipient does not complete the rating appropriate to her award within one year of the award date, her status will be reviewed. Special circumstances will be considered. Copies of her log book and reports from her instructor will be subject to verification if required by the Placer Gold scholarship Committee. If her progress is not acceptable, all funds paid out must be reimbursed to Placer Gold Ninety-Nines Aviation Scholarship fund within 60 days.

The scholarship monies will be paid in increments directly to the flight school or independent flight instructor conducting the training. Receipts showing hours flown and signed by both student and instructor must be submitted before funds are awarded.

Neither the Placer Gold Chapter of the Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots, Inc., the Southwest Section of the Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots, Inc., nor the Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots, Inc., nor their members, agents, or representatives are responsible for the quality of any training received with this scholarship, nor for any accident, incident, or any other event which may occur while the recipient of this scholarship is performing flight training, or activities related thereto.

I hereby release the Ninety-Nines and any of its affiliated organizations from all actions, claims or demands that I, my assignee, heirs, distributors, guardians, and legal representatives now have or may hereafter have for injury or damage resulting from my participation in any activities related to this scholarship.

I agree to abide by all the terms and conditions specified in this application. I declare under penalty of perjury that all the information I have given here is true and correct and that I meet the eligibility requirement for the scholarship sought.
